

Appendix 1-Police Report

Violence 9 Theft 2 Burglary 3 TUMV 1 Arson 1 Total 16

As you can see there were 16 crimes reported across the ward during September.

One theft relates to a theft from a shop and the second a theft that occurred within a property during a party.

One burglary occurred in Stockton on Forest where keys and a vehicle were stolen. The vehicle was later recovered. The other two burglaries occurred in Strensall. In one a shed was entered and some power tools taken and in the second a garage was entered although nothing was taken.

The TUMV (theft from unattended motor vehicle) occurred in Strensall when items were taken from the back of a pick up parked on a driveway.

The arson relates to damage that was caused to an item of Play equipment in Strensall as reported by Parish Council.

Instances of anti social behaviour have been rare across the ward this month although we will continue to monitor this. Operation Liberate that targeted anti social behaviour during the summer will be repeated during October Half Term, covering Halloween, Mischief Night and Bonfire Night. I will update you with more details as we get close to that time.
